Admin history:	Glendon Hall was the site of the first classes of the new York University in 1961. When the university took up its present Downsview, Ontario location, Glendon College was established as the university's bilingual, undergraduate college, an affiliated autonomous faculty. In the late 1960s a proposal to relocate the college to the main campus was defeated and it remains a small, liberal arts college within York University. In addition to traditional liberal arts departments, Glendon also has departments in International Studies, Canadian Studies, Multidisciplinary Studies and Women's Studies. In addition, there is a School of Translation at the college which offers an undergraduate degree in translation as well as a Certificate Programme in Technical and Professional Writing (in English only). The college is headed by a principal assisted by a senior administrator. It has its own faculty council and a dean of students. The college has its own student-run radio station (Radio Glendon), art gallery (Glendon Gallery) and theatre (Theatre Glendon). The Glendon campus is served by the Frost Library. Students enrolled at the college must demonstrate proficiency in both official languages and take instruction offered in English and French.

**SERIES LEVEL DESCRIPTION**

Records of the Principal. — 1964-1972. — 4 m. of textual records. — 1 audio recording.

The Principal is appointed by the Board of Governors on the advice of the President and s/he is ultimately accountable to the Board. As the chief academic and administrative officer of the college, the Principal oversees the implementation of Senate and Faculty legislation. The Principal promotes and facilitates the academic programme, both in the planning and execution stages, and encourages the extra-curricular programs within the college. In addition, the Principal is responsible for personnel matters, including the recruitment tenure and promotion of faculty, for the promotion of research activity amongst the faculty, and for the maintenance of all personnel policies in line with collective agreements. In addition to these academic and personnel responsibilities, the Principal is the chief financial officer of the college, and therefore must strike the annual budget. The Principal also represents the college within the university and to external bodies. During the period covered by these records the following men served as Principal of Glendon College: Escott Reid (1966-1970) and Albert V. Tucker (1970-1976).

The series consists of the following subseries: I. Faculty Council, 1965-1972; II. Correspondence and papers, 1964-1970; III. Financial papers, 1965-1972; IV. Reports, 1967-1969. These records were transferred in accessions 1966-003, 1973-010 and 1974-020.

I. Faculty Council, 1965-1972, contains correspondence, reports, memoranda, minutes and financial documents relating to: the Faculty Council including minutes, reports, correspondence and background materials used by the Council, 1966-1972; several of its committees (Executive, Academic Policy and Planning, Admissions, Book Store, Curriculum, Examinations and Standards, Library, Nominating, Tenure and Promotion); several ad-hoc committees of the council struck for particular tasks (bilingualism, college government, Principal's Advisory Committee, on an advisory system for first year students); and Faculty Council ballots.

II. Correspondence and papers, 1964-1970, has correspondence and papers from the Principal's Office dealing with admissions, 1967-1969; the Alumni Association, 1968-1969; various university bodies (Faculty of Arts and Science, the Senate, the Office of the President, Board of Governors, etc); committees struck by the President (Academic Advisory Committee, 1965-1968, Administrative Advisory Committee, 1967-1969 and the President's Committee on Glendon College, 1968-1969); correspondence and reports from the several departments of the college and the Registrar's Office; material on the establishment of residences at the college and the Residence Council; and several files dealing with Student Affairs, especially on Student Forums held at the college, 1967-1969. In addition, there are several files relating to the recruitment of teaching and administrative staff at the college, 1965-1969, arranged alphabetically by surname or by department name.

III. Financial records, 1965-1972, contains financial records relating to expenditures (office supplies and expenditures, athletic costs, visiting lecturers, salaries), operating budgets for the years 1966-1971 and several files dealing with the 1971-72 budget.

IV. Reports, 1967-1969, consists of copies of reports of the college and York University.

**SERIES LEVEL DESCRIPTION**

Records of the Senior Administrator. — 1966-1974. — 76 cm. of textual records.

The Senior Administrator was responsible for the daily operations of the college including membership on most of the college committees, financial and budgetary matters (including personnel and salaries), food services, handling minor research grants, as well as routine administrative matters, such as the allotment of parking spaces, safety measures, and telephone requirements. During the period covered by these records Victor Berg served in this office.

Series consists of correspondence, reports, minutes and financial documents relating to: budgets, 1970-1974; committees of the college (Chairmen of Departments, Faculty Council Executive, College House Committee, Committee on the Future of Glendon College), 1968-1970; food services (including budgets and operating statements, and committee meetings), 1968-1974; the physical plant (including correspondence and reports from the campus superintendent, operations, property), 1966-1974; research (including Minor Research Committee and grants), 1966-1974; residence (including minutes of the Advisory Committee, Dons, fees, and files relating to both the Woods and Marion Hilliard Residences), 1966-1973, and files relating to security, salaries and personnel. These records were transferred in accession 1977-007.

The Dean of Students, who also served as the Master of Residence was responsible for most student matters relating to cultural affairs, social events, graduate fellowships, and all matters pertaining to residence life at the college.

**SERIES LEVEL DESCRIPTION**

Records relating to the Faculty Council. — 1967-1989. — 72 cm. of textual records.

The Faculty Council of Glendon College is the highest legislative body of the college. It makes decisions regarding curriculum, faculty appointments and tenure, and general academic policy. The council is composed of all full-time faculty and student representatives. In addition, members of the college administration have ex-officio status on the council. The council also has several standing committees dealing with aspects of the academic and College activities of Glendon: these include, Executive, Nominating, Academic Policy and Planning, Curriculum, Academic Standards, Teaching and Learning, Petitions and Library committees.

Series consists of the minutes of the meetings of the Faculty Council. These records were transferred in accessions 1976-034 and 1987-020; they are not necessarily the official minutes of the Faculty Council.

Records relating to the Glendon College Student Union. — 1971-1982.  
— 81 cm. of textual records.

The Student Union is the political and social voice of all students enrolled in the college and represents students on various College and University committees. Its executive consists of a President and Vice-President and Directors of Cultural Affairs, Bilingual Affairs, Academic Affairs, Clubs & Services, Communications and External Affairs. The body of the union is made up of annually elected councillors, first year representatives and representatives of each department and programme at the college. In addition, the Alumni Association is represented.

Series consists of the following subseries:

I. Minutes, 1973-1982; II. Correspondence and papers, 1971-1982; III. Financial records, 1973-1981; IV. Reports, 1972-1981; and V. Printed material, 1972-1982. These records were transferred in accession 1983-021.

III. Financial records, includes: audited statements, 1977-1981; operating grants, 1971-1982; requests for funds, 1973-1981; budgets, 1973-1975 and 1977-1980; Monthly accounts (including balance sheets, journal entries, bank statements, computer print-outs, telephone bills), 1976-1981 [incomplete].

IV. Reports, includes: reports of the Budget Committee, 1979; President, 1973-1974; Policy and Planning Committee, 1973-1974.

V. Printed material, includes material related to funding coming from external sources including the Canadian Federation of Students, Ontario Federation of Students, and the Ontario Council of University Faculty Associations.

**SERIES LEVEL DESCRIPTION**

Photographs. — 1950. — 30 photoprints : b&w, 20 x 25 cm. — Photonegatives : b&w.

Edward Rogers Wood (1866-1941) and Agnes Euphemia (Smart) Wood (1868-1950) acquired the Glendon Hall property in 1920, and set about converting it from a pioneer farm to a country estate. The estate's central focus was the manor house, Glendon Hall, completed in 1924 by the architectural firm of Molesworth, West and Secord. When Mrs. Wood died in 1950, the property and buildings (but not the furnishings and contents) passed by bequest to the University of Toronto "for the purposes of the Department of Botany." Before the furnishings were packed for disposition, Beverly Gaby (d.1994), the Woods' granddaughter commissioned Eaton's Photo Studio to shoot the manor house's principle rooms and adjacent formal gardens. There are 26 interior views and 4 exteriors in all. — Series consists of 30 photographs of Glendon Hall. These records were assigned accession number 1960-003.
