The Task Force on the Status of Women Graduate Students was formed in 1989 in response to the COU Status of Women Committee report "Women in the Universities of Ontario"(1987) and its reported impact in 1988. The Task Force was to review and investigate the status of women graduate students at York with specific reference to the issues addressed in the COU report, to respond to its recommendations, and to suggest any further recommendations in light of investigation and review.

Series consists of minutes of meetings (1989-1990), research and resource files, including the report on York University Status of Women, 'Equity for Women: The First Decade'(1985); and Linda Briskin's manuscript for 'Feminist Pedagogy', 1990.

Series 4. Women's Studies Working Group records. — 1985-1989. — 48 cm. of textual records.

In 1985, a Women's Studies Working Group, with support from the Office of the Vice-President (Academic), was set up to develop co-ordinated projects for the Women's Studies Programmes at York. It was composed of three Women's Studies Programme Co-ordinators, the Advisor to the President on the Status of Women, and representatives of the Canadian Woman Studies/Les cahiers de la femme, the Nellie Langford Rowell Library, undergraduate Women's Studies programmes, and graduate Women's Studies students. One of the goals and accomplishments of this group was the establishment of the Women's Studies Graduate Programme.
