Accession Title and Dates of Creation William Edward Mann fonds. -- 1935-1990.

Physical Description of Materials 37 feet (11.3 m.) of textual records, sound recordings, and moving image materials.

Scope and Content Note Materials accumulated by Professor Mann during his years of teaching and research. They are divided into three series: Series 1: Courses taught and taken; Series 2: Subject Files, and; Series 3: Audiovisual materials

Series 1: Courses Taught & Taken (boxes 1-4): boxes 1-3 contain files from courses Prof. Mann taught, while Box 4 contains files from courses he took. [The exception is file #45, which contains materials from a course Mann took (at U of T in 1942, "The Family"), and from a course Mann taught (at United College, Winnipeg in 1960, "Family & Community").] These course files are composed primarily of materials from York University courses and from Trinity College courses, University of Toronto.

Please note that, in some cases, it was unclear whether files in this series related to a course taught or taken by Mann, or whether the file is composed solely of notes Prof. Mann took while reading. Therefore, these files have been organised by course number or title, or, in the absence of these, by file content.

Series 2: Subject Files (boxes 5-38): This series contains extensive files in fields of special interest to Prof. Mann. There are also numerous files of correspondence and student papers. Included within these files are the following subjects and topics: Atypical Behaviour; Health, Science & Innovators; Religious Studies; Sexuality; Social Actions & Concerns; Societies & Socialisation; and Student Papers. The bulk of the accession consists of Series 2.

Notes on Processing of the Materials These Papers were received in various states of order. Initially, it was difficult to understand how Professor Mann had grouped the files, except perhaps by date or by subject matter. His order has been maintained as much as possible. Thus, there are occasionally sequential sets of files ranging from sets of two, up to sets of ten. For example, Police Deviance files # 1-7 have been tied together according to Professor Mann's original filing system. Where the original filing system has not been maintained, the files have been cross-referenced so that information on various subjects may be retrieved. It should be noted that files elsewhere in the collection will have further information and materials (eg. re: courses he taught). In the File List, cross-referencing should include all of these materials under each applicable file. (Also, see the General Cross-Referencing List in Appendix I.)

Physical Description of Materials 32.5 ft. (6.6 m.) in 78 boxes.

Scope and Content Note **Files 74-139** contain materials on Atypical Behaviour. The original filing system has been maintained as much as possible, but some files have been reorganised according to content, then alphabetised and filed as units. For example, this subseries begins with a set of two files labelled Alcoholism and ends with a file on Therapies for Mental Patients.

Files 140-222 have been loosely labelled Community Studies, or Societies & Socialisation. Grouped in this category are files which look at people within societies and organisations, and at the organisations and societies which people form. For example, included here are files on Prisoners and Penal Institutions, as well as files on a study of Burlington and some reactions of Burlingtonites to the study.

N.B.: **Files 140-222 have been alphabetised by key words in the file title. (Key words have been highlighted in the File List.)**

Files 223-303 contain confidential and/or restricted materials. These include correspondence, questionnaires, surveys, and student papers. Student papers have been further delineated re: dissertations, essays, papers and theses.

Files 304-403 contain general correspondence. These files are ordered by date and should be referenced for further information and materials re: any topic in this collection.

Files 404-493 contain files on studies and examinations of

various religions.

N.B.: Files 404-493 have been arranged in the File List alphabetically, by a highlighted key word.

Files 494-542 have been loosely designated Health, Science & Innovators files. These include: Prof. Mann's examinations of Chiropractics; source materials for Prof. Mann's book "Kooks, Oddballs & Dingbats"; his work with Dr. Motoyama in Japan; his extensive research into the life and works of Wilhelm Reich and Ergonomics; parapsychology; an unpublished manuscript, "Vital Health & Energy" (which had previously been published as "Orgone, Reich & Eros"); and scientific scepticism.

Files 543-566 contain information on Sexuality and sex studies. These files are cross-referenced in the File List with materials on Sexual Deviance and Atypical Sexuality as found in the Atypical Behaviour files. (Also, see the General Cross-Referencing List in Appendix I.)

[note: Included with Sexuality is a cross-reference to a file on Prostitution. This file has also been referenced to Organised Crime files, and to Atypical Behaviour files.]

Files 567-636 contain files which have materials on Social Action. These include looks at community, individual and organisational activism.

[note: see also files on Social Concerns.]

Files 637-679 contain files on Social Concerns. This is a varied group of files with information on a broad range of topics. For example, there are files on environmental concerns, and files on concerns about psychiatric patients. The range extends from local to global issues.

[note: see also files on Social Action.]

Files 680-683 contain three files which hold information on Mann's travels to India, China, and Japan. These materials should also be cross-referenced with parallel files. For example, Mann went to India primarily to examine a Rajneesh commune in Poona. Thus, the file on India should be consulted when examining Rajneeshism.

File 683 contains Professor Mann's Curriculum Vitae.
